

Alaska Trophy Outfitters Gear List- Bears

- Rifle
- Shells (2 Boxes)- Recommend Nosler Partition, Triple Shock, Swift A-Frame 180+ Grain
- Leather Hiking boots + Extra Insoles
- Hip Boots or Gore Tex Waist High Waders- Recommend LaCrosse, Simms, Cabela's
- Gaiters- Recommend Kuiu Yukon
- Day Pack
- Binoculars
- Rain Gear- It is imperative to have good rain gear!! Recommend Kuiu Yukon
- Water Bottle- Nalgene is best
- Camera
- Head Lamp & Batteries
- Pocket Knife
- Walking Stick- Recommend Leki
- Socks- 5 pair
- Underwear- 5 pair
- Lightweight Long John Top & Bottom (2 each)- Most of us use the Kuiu Merino 185
- 2 pairs hunting Pants
- Medium Pullover
- Wind Stopper Jacket
- Insulating Jacket & Pant- We use the Kuiu Superdown
- Balaclava- Very Important- Keeping your neck and head warm while glassing is huge!
- Stocking Cap & Ball Cap
- 2 pairs of gloves, one lightweight and one heavy
- Camp Shoes/Sandals- Crocs are great
- Sun Glasses
- Couple Books for down time/weather days
- Sleeping Bag- Recommend Rated to 15 degrees
- Dry Bags- for all your gear.

If you'd like to discuss gear in detail, feel free to contact me. Since the majority of our camps are accessed via Super Cub, hunters are restricted to a 65lb weight limit. Your gear should fit into two smaller dry bags, your day pack and your rifle in a soft case. NO LARGE BAGS, they will not fit into the plane
